## Medi-Cal Reminder: QNatal Advanced®

## **Noninvasive Prenatal Testing for Fetal Aneuploidy (NIPT)**

Quest Diagnostics test offering 92777 - QNatal Advanced® (CPT: 81420)

According to the current Medi-Cal Provider Manual, Noninvasive Prenatal Testing for Fetal Aneuploidy (branded at Quest Diagnostics as the QNatal Advanced ™ test), may be billed with CPT-4 code 81507 (fetal aneuploidy [trisomy 21, 18, and 13] DNA sequence analysis of selected regions using maternal plasma, algorithm reported as a risk score for each trisomy) or **81420** (fetal chromosomal aneuploidy genomic sequence analysis panel, circulating cell-free fetal DNA in maternal blood, must include analysis of chromosomes 13, 18, and 21). Coverage for noninvasive prenatal testing for fetal aneuploidy (cell-free fetal DNA testing) does not include screening for microdeletion syndromes, neural tube defect, or ventral wall defects. A *Treatment Authorization Request* (TAR) with documentation of the following criteria is required:

- Patient with singleton gestation only
- The patient has an increased risk of aneuploidy due to one or more of the following:
  - Maternal age 35 years or older at delivery
  - Fetal ultra-sonographic findings indicating an increased risk of aneuploidy
  - History of a prior pregnancy with a trisomy
  - Positive test result for aneuploidy, including first trimester, sequential, or integrated screen, or a quadruple screen
  - Parental balanced Robertsonian translocation with increased risk of fetal trisomy 13 or trisomy 21 Concurrent or repeat use of noninvasive prenatal testing (NIPT) during the same pregnancy is not covered.

**Note**: Coverage for NIPT for fetal aneuploidy (cell-free fetal DNA testing) does not include screening for microdeletion syndromes, neural tube defect or ventral wall defects.
