

Understanding testing costs: Indiana's 50 most shoppable tests

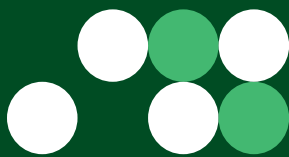

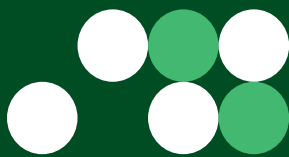

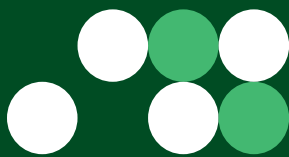
